Year 7

During term three the students will be looking at Jesus’ teachings considering topics such as the “greatest commandment”, ‘good Samaritan’ and other selected parables.

Pray that students are attentive in their classes and gain great insight and wisdom about how they can lead lives reflecting Jesus love for them as they study.

Year 8

Students are focusing on the difference Christianity makes in their personal life; Obedience and who is in control are major themes as they consider what Jesus said, whether they believe it and how they respond.

Year 9

Year 9 students are looking at life designed by God and gospel basics in their third term seminar.

Pray they will gain a clear understanding of how God intended life to be, how the gospel addresses our sins and that they respond well to this message.

Year 10

In their third term seminar students will be considering the difficulties life brings and how to deal with them including what is worth fighting for in light of Jesus teachings. **Pray** that students will come to see Jesus as the way and means to face their challenges in life.
