## From Rev Phill's Desk

### Gathering as God's people: Shaped By God's Word

Community life requires a focus or something that binds the group together.

Some people place the style of the weekly gathering at the centre. Ethnicity or age can also be the focus. Some communities are united by a common desire to care for one another. These can all be understandable and even commendable bases. But for a group to remain united, then preserving this common focus will be paramount. Those who do not 'fit' or agree with the focus can find themselves excluded.

Bonhoffer argues that Christ should be the centre of our community. He says that "life together under the Word will remain sound and healthy only where it does not form itself into a movement, an order, a society. A community shaped by God's word avoids the errors of tribalism, romanticism and idealism".

According to Bonhoffer, if the word of God is at the centre, then our love will extend even as far as our enemies. We will not seek to exclude. Rather we will be pastoral, speaking the truth in love to one another.

The moment we shift our focus from God's word, we stop being a spiritual community and become like any other earthly society.
