Bible Reading

Here is how to develop a regular Bible reading pattern:

Pause - stop what you are doing. Choose where you will read (ie gospel of Mark).

Pour Over - choose a passage you can read and reread (20-40 verses in length).

Ponder - think about what was said, why it was said and what it means.

Pray - ask God to help you apply what you have learnt from the passage.
