Reaching Penshurst

There are 12,660 people living in Penshurst. The average age is 38, with a household consisting of 2 parents and one child. Houses are owner occupied whilst units are rented. Chinese ancestry is still the highest (24.5%) followed by English (16.1%) and Australian (14.3%). Nepalese ancestry is rising (9.4%).

No religion (29.2%), Catholicism (21.4%) and Hinduism (9.8%) are all greater than protestant churches (Anglicans are 6.8%).
