Murder of Charlie Kirk

It has been in the news and social media. What should we make of it all?

- 1. Charlie Kirk's death is a tragedy. Resorting to violence is never good.
- 2. Charlie was a Christian. Watch any video where he talks about his Christian faith and he shares the gospel.
- 3. Charlie was for free speech. He went to universities to interact with people who disagreed with him. It is a healthy society that can do this.
- 4. Charlie was a nationalist. Here is where disagreement about him begins. His focus is specifically on American issues and virtues.
- 5. Charlie was a Republican. He held strong views on gun control, LGBTQ+ issues, role of government and white privilege.

His death was neither as a martyr or hateful racist. The response to his death isn't entrenched rhetoric. It's prayer (1 Tim 2:1-4) and proclamation of the gospel.

Prayer

How to pray for the persecuted church

- Pray the believers will sense God's presence (Hebrews 13:5)
- Pray they would feel connected to the body of Christ (1 Cor 12:20, 26)
- Pray they would experience God's comfort (2 Cor 1:3-5)
- · Pray they may have more opportunities to share the gospel (Col 4:3)
- · Pray for boldness in making Christ known (Phil 1:14)
