Religious discrimination

Australia doesn't have any laws protecting the expression of religious faith. It hasn't been required. Recent motions (including anti-conversion therapy laws) raise the possibility of prosecution (and prison) for expressing the Christian faith.

A submission has been made to the NSW Law Reform Commission ([click here](#) to read).

Legal action has been taken against Sacred Heart Girls College in Oakleigh for failure to use a teacher's preferred pronoun.

Synod members and all parishioners to write to, and where appropriate, meet with, their local state and federal members to impress upon them the importance of protecting people against religious discrimination and maintaining.
