'Covid-Safe' Sunday Services

Two new church services are now being run on Sunday mornings:

- From 9:00am 10:00am, an *English-only* service of Holy Communion.
- From 11:00am 12:00pm, a *bi-lingual* service with Communion served once a month. For families, 2021 Sunday School will start on 31 January. The children will enjoy Godly Play presented in a Covid-safe manner.

From 17 January, the 11 am service will be separated into English and Chinese after the news announcements. We will start with bi-lingual worship, prayer and news announcements together. After the news announcements, the English congregation will go to the hall and the Chinese congregation will remain in the church. Phill and David will each share the Bible and their teaching.

Booking your seat: Due to 4m2 rule for social distancing, our church can only hold **52 people**. To control numbers and ensure contact tracing **everyone must 'book' their seat in advance for the service you choose.** Please arrive early.

**Please note: Wearing a mask is strongly recommended.

A **'live-streaming'** of our two services is also available on **YouTube** - 9:00am English-only and from 17 January, 11:00am Chinese-only. Please see our website (**www.penshurstanglican.org**) for further instructions.

Register at the foyer

To maintain the Covid-Safe procedures, people entering the church buildings outside the church service hours are required to check in using the QR code displayed on each glass door at the foyer entrance.

This will help us to keep a record on who was at the church and when. If there is an outbreak, the NSW health department is then able to contact those people who were at the church.

David graduated with Bachelor of Divinity at Theological Seminary of Malaysia in 1986 and MA (Th) at SMBC in 2009. He was a minister and missionary in the Diocese of West Malaysia, involved in parish ministries, church planting among the native people, prison ministry, orphanages, and church planting in Indonesia.

David and his family moved to Sydney in 2003. He was the Mandarin Minister of the West Sydney Chinese Christian Church (2003-2010) and the Rector of St Mark's Anglican Church Granville (2010-2020). David is a member of the Archbishop Advisory to the Chinese Ministry and the Vice-Chairman of the Chinese Christian Mission Australia. For the past 17 years in Sydney, David had assisted churches and parishes planted about 10 Chinese congregations and Bible study groups or fellowships.

David and Magdalene love camping and motor homing. David loves carpentry and Magdalene gardening.

We look forward to his first service on 10 January 2021.
