Building Renovations

It has been exciting to see people return to our Sunday services. We are all enjoying more time to fellowship as we share lunch once again.

I think our gatherings will be even better once the kitchen renovations are complete. With that in mind, here is the update on our progress so far.

The building committee has submitted architectural drafts to the parish council. They include the following features:

- a fully functional kitchen
- greater natural light in the kitchen area
- cupboards in both the kitchen and foyer
- polished floors in the kitchen
- carpet tiles in the foyer

The parish council has approved these plans. The Sydney Diocese has also given its support.

Rev Phill's report continued:

The building committee is now in the process of obtaining quotes in order to present the full cost to the parish. The money for these renovations will come from our church's building account.

Once quotes have been received, a general meeting of the parish will be held. At this meeting, the parish will be asked to vote on a motion to proceed with the renovation.

We are thankful to God for this opportunity and for the generosity of His people. I encourage you to commit these plans to our Lord in prayer

David Lakos — Chaplain St George Hospital

Dear faithful prayer partners,

There are a few current things for which I wanted to give you an update for your prayers.

Praise God – volunteer chaplains are back! – Yes, from early March my volunteer chaplain colleagues were able to start returning to their ministry in the hospital – almost exactly a year after they were "stood down" because of COVID! It has been wonderful to have them back; and they have been warmly welcomed by the staff in the wards where they visit week by week.



But we are also finding that this is a time of...

Transition and loss – This year three members of our team have decided to 'retire' from their chaplaincy involvement (in addition to the three who we farewelled at the end of last year). So we are feeling the loss of these valued colleagues! Just as happened so much for everyone during 2020, we are seeking to navigate this time of transition. Please pray with us as we seek to press ahead in our hospital ministry while adjusting to change and loss in our team.

Training course coming up — After a year of waiting, we are about to start our orientation course for potential new volunteers to join our chaplaincy team! We have seven people from local churches who have signed up for the course, which will run over five Mondays (starting 26th April). We would greatly value your prayers for the course — and especially for our seven 'students' as we seek to discern with them whether hospital chaplaincy is the right 'fit' for their personality, gifts and interests.

- † Generosity—praise God for his glorious generosity to us, from the life of Jesus to his daily care for us each day. Have you been challenged by God to be more generous? Talk to God about it and be intentional in your generosity.
- † Ponder our choices: "This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live 20 and that you may love the Lord your God, listen to his voice, and hold fast to him. "Deut 30:19-20

Godly Play

This month in Godly Play, the children will be looking at "Knowing Jesus in a New Way". These stories focus on Jesus' appearances after Easter. They are new stories and we are excited to tell them over the next 7 weeks.

After the children have gathered together in a circle and heard the story, they are invited to work on their own. We allow the children to respond to the story in their own way, trusting that God's spirit is moving in them. The children are encouraged to work quietly on their own. They may work with some of the items that form the stories, like the wooden Holy Family or Noah's Ark, they may do some art or colour in or they may choose to read a book.

It has been wonderful to see so many children joining us in Godly Play each week. We are now getting 10 to 14 children regularly. This means it will soon be time to divide into 2 classes. We have the space, we have the materials however we don't have enough helpers.

We are on the lookout for more assistants who can be trained as doorkeepers. You will help set up the room before church, bring the children into the room, assist any child as needed, help as needed during the children's work time, serve the feast, talk with the children, assist in returning children to their parents and pack up the room afterwards.

Being a doorkeeper is a lovely way of getting to know our children. You will be amazed at what they come up with during our time together. If you are interested, please speak with Merilyn or Tiny. We really do need more parents to be involved.
