Gathering as God's people: Unity

"God hates visionary dreaming; it makes the dreamer proud and pretentious. The man who fashions a visionary ideal of community, demands that it be realized by God, by others, and by himself. He enters the community of Christians with his demands, sets up his own law, and judges the brethren and God Himself accordingly." (Bonhoffer)

In our minds, we can have the picture of the perfect church community. The question is, how can we turn our current church into this perfect church? How can we "create" unity?



Jesus Unites Us

The answer is – we can't. Unity is Jesus' work. We are united in him. He is the one who removes all barriers between people (Ephesian 2:12-21).

Too often, our attempts at unity apart from God rely upon rules and regulations. Unity starts to look more like uniformity and certainly isn't based upon grace.

If we are united in Christ, then we can be diverse yet have the same love, the same purpose. This requires compassion, kindness, humility, patience and gentleness without the expectation of reciprocation (Colossians 3:12-14).
